



COMPULSORY DOCUMENTS FOR HOUSE OWNERS´ VISA	
1	1 fulfilled and signed visa application with 2 fresh color photographs, front view, uncovered face, over white background.
2	Travel passport, whose validity must exceed in at least 3 months visa's expiry date
3	Other valid or expired travel passports (copy of all the pages and original)
4	Copy of all the pages of the domestic passport.
5	Copy of all the pages of the travel passport.
6	Medical insurance valid for the whole period of the intended stay in Schengen territory, covering all medical expenses for a minimum of 30.000€.
7	Signed Medical Declaration Form in which the applicant commits himself to hire a travel insurance whenever uses the visa subsequently to the first travel.
8	In case of minors traveling without their parents or legal tutors, copy of an authorization before notary by both of them must be submitted. For minors traveling with just one of them, such authorization must be signed only by the other parent.
9	Power of attorney and copy of the representative's domestic passport if the passport.
10	Reservation of roundtrip plane ticket (only for the first application as property owner)
11	Financial guarantees (job certificate indicating salary)
12	Money availability (57€ per day/person or credit card with the extract of the bank account (extracts obtained in the Internet will not be admitted), travel checks or a recent certificate of exchanged currency.
13	In case of non-Russian citizens applying for visa, they must have residence permit in the Russian Federation (minimum one year) (this is not applicable to citizens from Armenia, Belarus, Georgia, Turkmenistan and Uzbekistan).
14	Original of the Note issued by the Register of Property "Nota Simple" issued within 3 months prior to the day of the visa application.
15	Copy of the purchase agreement before notary.
16	In case of invitation to relatives, certificate accrediting family links must be provided.
This Consulate General informs that according to the Royal Decree 2393/2004 of December 30th:	
1. It has the right to require any other additional documents it may deem as appropriate (Art. 28.4)	
2. The application must be delivered personally by the applicant or through a legal representative (fourth additional clause, points 2-3).	
3. Visa application should be resolved within 3 months (eighth additional clause).	
4. Issued visas must be collected within 1 month. Otherwise, the Consulate will consider that the applicant has renounced to the visa and will proceed to file the application.
